## <u>Art/DT</u>

1<sup>st</sup> half - DT This term we will be exploring CAD desktop publishing program Inkscape and designing a product that can be laser cut from either wood or plastic. Starting with creating basic shapes, we will move onto experimenting with joining and manipulating 2D shapes and sourcing images and shapes from the internet to use in our products.

### 2<sup>nd</sup> half - Art - 'Line, Shape and Colour'

Pupils will explore the work of abstract artists Wassily Kandinsky and Hilma af Klint. Pupils will investigate mark-making through the medium of mono-printmaking, oil pastel and collage. This unit develops from previous baseline skills, aptitude and imagination in art and design. All pupils produce an A3 piece of art.
