## English/Reading/Drama

#### **Guided Reading Lessons**

Students will take part in a guided reading lesson once a week, using a reading schemes which supports their phonics learning. Students will also be answering comprehension questions based on the texts studied in English.

#### **Phonics Lessons**

Students will continue to complete 3 phonic lessons a week using the Twinkl Phonics Scheme. Work is appropriately targeted to individual reading levels.



#### Drama Lessons

Students will have a weekly Drama lesson where they will complete activities to develop use of their voice, body and expression in contrasting performances/activities. Lessons additionally support our English texts.

#### **Text based lessons**

t-based

Students will take part in weekly text-based English lessons covering a range of different writing and reading genres, competing numerous activities including: descriptive writing, writing in a diary style, formal writing, character profiles and newspaper report writing. This terms texts are 'Moon Man' by Tomi Unger and 'The boy at the back of the

class' by Onjali Q. Rauf.



#### Maths

This term's primary focus in maths will be **Measure** (Time, Money, Length, Perimeter, Area, Mass & Capacity) followed by **Fractions** (including decimals).

In addition, students will continue to embed and consolidate their understanding of place value, number and the four operations. We will also learn how to use calculators effectively.

We encourage all students to log onto their Sumdog accounts at home to further support



# 3SG & 3MS Spring Term 2025

## Science



Our first topic this term will be **Light**. We will learn how we see things, how light travels and how shadows are created.

Our second topic will be **Electricity.** We will look at creating circuits, identifying issues with circuits, understand voltage and be able to use recognised symbols in a circuit diagram.

## **Computing and Online Safety**

This term we are focusing on online safety. Students will identify all the different opportunities the internet provides for learning, creativity and communication and look at the risks that can affect their safety. Students will learn how to recognise, respond to an prevent online bullying. Students will explore the concepts of plagiarism and digital footprints. Throughout the term, students will prepare and cook a range of recipes. The ability to chop, slice, and grate food safely and effectively is the main focus of this term.

In addition to using these skills, students will be learning how to use ovens and hobs safelv.

Students will focus this half term on learning to prepare and cook quick and easy meals that will develop their skills and independence within cooking.

# Art / DT

**DT -** Students will learn and revise the basics of FDM 3D printing using CAD program Tinkercad. We will research, design and print a PLA phone or tablet stand. Creativity and problem solving will be a large focus when making design decisions for our product.

#### Art - 'Portraits Project'

Pupils will explore the remarkable life and portraiture of Frida Kahlo and identify how she reflects her own personality and feelings in her work. We will explore facial expressions, the composition of a face, techniques of sketching, collage and monoprinting. They will gain understanding of the cultural style and varying techniques and will imitate the work confidently and create their own self portrait.

#### **The World Around Us**

Students are learning about 'The History of Railways' by looking back in time at the evolution of trains and the railway systems. Students will develop their questioning skills, identify and interpret sources and learn how to

recognise change.
